Easy to use, simply insert the DVD into any computer and select a chapter from the navigation bar. Links are embedded into the text, allowing the reader to view videos, mp3's, pdf scores and websites. An internet connection is not required for the text portion of the book.

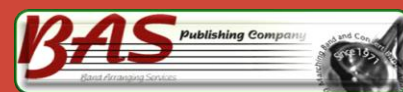
